

Public Interest Disclosure Act annual report

Background

PIDA is B.C.'s Public Interest Disclosure Act (PIDA), whistleblower protection legislation which applies to health authorities effective June 1, 2023. It provides legal confidentiality and reprisal protections to current and former employees and health professionals of Fraser Health who speak up about serious or systemic wrongdoing.

In June 2023, Fraser Health implemented the PIDA program to fulfill its obligations under the legislation.

Annual report for fiscal year ending March 31, 2025

PIDA requires that an annual report be prepared on all disclosures of wrongdoing that have been made in that year. The following are statistics relating to the period April 1, 2024 to March 31, 2025.
